

Curiosity — A Good Team Argument Has Different Checks

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Scientific teams do not need everyone to do the same mental task. One check can ask whether the arithmetic is right. Another can ask whether a model is being used outside its stated condition. A third can ask what evidence is missing. A final check can make the limit visible in the sentence.

Those checks strengthen an argument without turning fictional roles into claims about people or outcomes. The evidence still has to earn each conclusion.
