

## Curiosity: Reading a Representation Carefully

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Scientific displays often look more definite than the evidence behind them. A labeled peak or signal can be genuinely useful: it helps a reader compare a pattern with a model. It also carries assumptions about what was labeled, what was omitted, and how much uncertainty remains.

Practicing careful language with fictional cards builds a transferable habit: let a representation inform a claim, but do not let it silently become more evidence than it is.
